

## **EMBASSY OF THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA IN STOCKHOLM**

## REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVEL TO KENYA DURING CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

The Embassy of the Republic of Kenya in Stockholm wishes to inform members of public as follows:

- 1. The updated list of countries exempted from quarantine can be accessed on <a href="https://www.kcaa.or.ke/sites/default/files/covid-19/documents/exempted states 3.pdf">https://www.kcaa.or.ke/sites/default/files/covid-19/documents/exempted states 3.pdf</a>
- 2. All arriving passengers on international flights should meet the following criteria:
  - Have a negative PCR based COVID 19 test carried out within 96 hours before travel obtained from an authorized laboratory in the country of departure.
  - Travelers are required to provide a digital COVID-19 certificate for validation upon arrival. The Ministry of Health of the Republic of Kenya has launched a digital system for verification of COVID-19 test results named 'Trusted Travel'.
  - The traveller is thus required to upload their COVID-19 PCR test results onto the Trusted Travel platform by registering and signing into <a href="https://login.panabios.org/cas/login?service=https%3A%2F%2Ftrustedtravel.panabios.org%2Faccounts%2Flogin%2F%3Fnext%3D%252F">https://login.panabios.org/cas/login?service=https%3A%2F%2Ftrustedtravel.panabios.org%2Faccounts%2Flogin%2F%3Fnext%3D%252F</a>.   - Have a body temperature that is NOT above 37.5° C (99.5°F);
  - Do not have a persistent cough, difficulty in breathing or other flu-like symptoms.
  - Must submit the Travelers Health Surveillance Form prior to travel. The form is available
    on https://ears.health.go.ke/airline\_registration/ The traveller will be issued with a QR
    code that should be presented at the health desk upon arrival into the country.
- 3.
