COMMENCEMENT OF IEBC REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN BERLIN

1. The Embassy of the Republic of Kenya in the Federal Republic of Germany, with concurrent non-residential accreditation to The Czech Republic, Poland, Romania and Bulgaria, has the honour to inform that the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC) shall conduct Diaspora Voter Registration Exercise at the Embassy from **Friday, 21st January 2022 until Friday, 4th February 2022** during official working hours, **Monday to Friday: 9:00 a.m. – 13:00 p.m.** and from **14:00 p.m. – 17:00 p.m.**, in strict adherence to **2G+ COVID-19 protocols (full vaccination and current rapid test)**.
2. Kenyan citizens who reside within the European Union (EU) and wish to register to vote in the general elections must fulfil the following conditions:
 - I. **Produce a valid Kenyan passport, (date of validity of passport, not passport type)**
 - II. **Be eighteen (18) years of age and above, and**
 - III. **Present their identification document to the Registration Officer stationed at the Embassy.**
3. The address of the Embassy is **Rheinbabenallee 49, 14199 Berlin**.
4. Public Transportation to the Embassy:
 - 4.1 **Bus 110: Platz am Wilden Eber**
 - 4.2 **Train U3: Podbielskiallee**
5. This entire exercise will be conducted by officers from the IEBC. the Embassy's role is purely facilitative.
6. During this exercise, voters previously registered in Kenya will have to change their voting station to **Berlin**.
7. Please note that a voter registered in the Diaspora will only be voting for the Presidential elective position.
8. The IEBC is working with the Diaspora to agree on registration by appointment in order to facilitate a smooth process.
